### What

Saturday School classes offer opportunities to improve art skills, try new art forms and build a portfolio. Established in 1922, Saturday School offers quality art instruction to youths and adults each fall and spring.

Eight-week classes offer options for youths in grades 2 through 12 and adults. Herron juniors and seniors teach Saturday School classes. Class length is three hours each week. Class sizes are limited to allow for highly individualized instruction in a variety of media including ceramics, drawing, printmaking and more.

Saturday School culminates with an Open House exhibition and awards ceremony held on the last Saturday afternoon of each session (no morning classes) and sponsored in part by The Great Frame Up and Prizm – The Artist's Supply Store.

### Costs

**Tuition** Youths \$170 Adults \$200 *Enroll in 2 courses or enroll 2 household members for \$320.*

**Lab Fee** \$30 additional lab fee for some courses

**Parking** \$25 IUPUI parking permit for Saturday School semester

## Course Descriptions

### GRADES 2 through 5

#### **Elementary Art Sampler – MORE!**

A sampler art class for children in grades 2 through 5. Students will explore a variety of materials and techniques of painting, drawing, clay and sculpture. Sketchbook activities will enrich each week's lesson. Discovering different artists and their work will also be a part of this course. Enrollment limited to 20 students to maintain a teacher-student ratio of 1 to 10. Lab fee covers cost of all art supplies and snacks each week.

**Afternoon Session: 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Lab Fee: \$30**

#### **Exploring Your World: Drawing and Printmaking**

Children in grades 2 through 5 will explore their worlds through creating a variety of drawings and prints. Art activities include printmaking on fabric and combining drawing and printmaking to create mixed media art. Sketchbook activities will enrich each week's lesson. Discovering different artists and their work will also be a part of this course. Enrollment limited to 20 students to maintain a teacher-student ratio of 1 to 10. Lab fee covers cost of all art supplies and snacks each week.

## Course Descriptions

### GRADES 6 through 12 and ADULTS

#### Ceramics

Create with clay! Learn about the nature of clay and how to use the pottery wheel and handbuilding methods. Students will explore a variety of techniques, surface designs and firing processes. Class is held north of the main IUPUI campus at Herron Sculpture & Ceramics Building, 1350 N. Indiana Ave.

**Afternoon Session:** 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Optional studio time starts 2<sup>nd</sup> class, Noon to 1 p.m. **Lab Fee:** \$30

#### Comic Illustration: Beginning to Advanced

Class offers instruction for all experience levels in different forms of illustration, focusing on hand-drawn comic books and related art forms. Beginning students will learn basic character development and storyboarding while advanced students will further develop their comic illustration skills. Students will have opportunities to explore digital storytelling using Wacom® tablets along with Adobe® Photoshop®.

**Afternoon Session:** 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. **Lab Fee:** \$30

#### Drawing 1

Learn to draw. Students will develop foundational drawing skills using dry media such as charcoal and pencil. Sketchbook activities will enrich lessons. No previous drawing experience required.

**Afternoon Session:** 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

#### Portfolio Development: Drawing and Watercolor Painting

Designed to help students who are interested in furthering their studies in visual arts and developing a portfolio of their work. The course will cover traditional and contemporary concepts and techniques in drawing and watercolor painting. Students will develop observational and critical thinking skills while visually cultivating their own voice. Sketchbook will be used as a resource. Students will need to bring drawing supplies. Lab fee covers watercolor supplies.

**Morning Session:** 9 a.m. to Noon. **Lab Fee:** \$30

#### Painting with Oils

Explore oil painting and learn about the visual elements of color, light and form. Students will acquire a basic knowledge of materials and techniques, learning to “look” as they paint from direct observation. Multiple small paintings will be made. Sketchbook will be used as a resource. No previous painting experience required. Students will need to purchase most of their supplies, although some painting surfaces will be provided.

**Afternoon Session:** 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

#### Photography: Alternative Processes

From capture to print, this fun and creative class allows students to compose and explore black and white photography using alternative photographic processes. Processes taught include creating a pinhole camera and manipulating digital photographs and imagery in Adobe® Photoshop® then printing a paper negative that can be drawn on. The paper negative is brought into the darkroom, exposed onto photographic paper then developed in the darkroom. Students must bring a camera, their own photographic printing paper and USB drive. Lab fee covers darkroom chemicals and computer lab usage.

**Morning Session:** 9 a.m. to Noon. **Lab Fee:** \$30

#### Printmaking Exploration

Explore printmaking, a tactile, process-oriented medium that offers many options for rich visual effects. Students will learn printmaking techniques: monotypes, linoleum printing and plastic etching (Pronto Plate). The course will avoid the use of harsh chemicals and acids.
